Public Bodies (Admission to Meetings) Act 1960

Under this act, Any Parishioners/Visitors to the meetings are ONLY permitted to speak at 2 specified times and ONLY through the chairman at all times.

Agenda items named Public Participation.

The first, is there for Parishioners to 'bring up items for consideration by Councillors or to be made agenda items for the next meeting.'

The second, at the end of the meeting and is when 'only items discussed at the current meeting can be discussed and noted in the minutes.'
